Personal Equipment

Essential

- PFD. (Personal Flotation Device)
- Bailer & sponge (1 per canoe)
- Carabiners (2)
- 25' Painter
- Paddle
- Matches, in waterproof container
- Knife, pocket
- Compass
- First aid kit, personal
- 20 ft. nylon cord
- Sunglasses, case, safety loop
- Bandanna (2)
- Money, identification, fishing permit (all in waterproof bag)
- Pencil or pen
- Notebook, pocket size for Journal
- Toilet paper
- Trowel (1 per canoe)

Optional

- Comb
- Watch
- Nail clippers
- Flashlight, small; extra batteries
- Fishing gear
- Camera/film
- Plastic bags, assorted sizes
- Bible or prayer book

Crew Gear to be Decided by Crew

- Tents
- Cooking gear
- Stoves
- Kitchen gear
- Crew First Aid Kit
- Repair kit
- Duct Tape
- Dry bag(s) for Crew gear
- Water containers (3-5 gal) (1 gallon per person per day)

Clothing

- Dry Bag-waterproof (No Frames)
- Rain gear
- Windbreaker, hooded, water-repellent
- Shirt, long-sleeved
- Sweater or sweatshirt-warm,, long-sleeved
- T-shirts (3)
- Undershorts, boxers (3)
- Socks, medium weight (3-5), wool or polypro
- Shorts (2)
- Pants (1)
- Swim trunks
- Tennis shoes (for campwear)
- Water sandals or old sneakers for canoe
- Work gloves, (1 pair)
- Wide brim hat and wool watch cap

Sleeping Gear

- Sleeping bag, protected to keep dry!
- Sleeping pad
- Share tent within crew
- Ground cloth, shared within crew
- Sleeping clothes, gym shorts and T-shirt

Eating Gear

- Bowl, plastic
- Cup
- Spoon, large
- Water bottle, polyethylene (2- 1 liter size)

Toilet Articles

- Soap (biodegradable)
- comb
- toothbrush & paste
- Metal Mirror
- Washcloth
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Lip salve
- Hand Towels(1)
- Bath Towels (2 required) 1 beach towel
- Shaving gear
